

FIFTH SUNDAY AFTER PENTECOST THE HOLY APOSTLE JUDE, BROTHER OF THE LORD ACCORDING TO THE FLESH

Troparion (4):

When the disciples of the Lord learned from the angel the glorious news of the resurrection and cast off the ancestral condemnation, they proudly told the apostles: Death has been plundered! Christ our God is risen, granting to the world great mercy.

Troparion (1):

As we know you to be Christ's relative and a steadfast martyr, O Jude, we praise you with sacred hymns. You trampled on error and kept the faith. And so on this day as we feast your memory through your prayers, O apostle, we receive release from our sins.

Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit.

Kontakion (2):

O Jude, because of your solid mind you were shown to be a chosen disciple and firm pillar of the Church of Christ. You proclaimed to the nations His holy word teaching them to believe in the one God from Whom you received glory and the gift of healing to cure the ills of those who flee to you, O apostle, worthy of all praise. Now and for ever and ever; Amen.

Kontakion (4):

My Savior and Deliverer from the grave, as God, has raised out of bondage the children of earth and shattered the gates of Hades; and as Master, He rose on the third day.

Prokimenon (4):

How great are Your works, O Lord; You have made all things in wisdom. Verse:Bless the Lord, O my soul; O Lord my God, You are exceedingly great. Prokimenon (8):

Epistle:Reading of the Epistle of St. Paul to the Romans(Rom 10,1-10)

Brethren: My heart's desire and prayer to God on their behalf is for salvation. I testify with regard to them that they have zeal for God, but it is not discerning. For, in their unawareness of the righteousness that comes from God and their attempt to establish their own [righteousness,] they did not submit to the righteousness of God. For Christ is the end of the law for the justification of everyone who has faith. Moses writes about the righteousness that comes from [the] law,

"The one who does these things will live by them." But the righteousness that comes from faith says, "Do not say in your heart, 'Who will go up into heaven?' (that is, to bring Christ down) or 'Who will go down into the abyss?' (that is,

to bring Christ up from the dead)." But what does it say? "The word is near you, in your mouth and in your heart" (that is the word of faith that we preach), for, if you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. For one believes with the heart and so is justified, and one confesses with the mouth and so is saved.

Alleluia Verses:

Verse (4):Poise yourself and advance in triumph and reign in the cause of truth, and meekness, and justice.

You have loved justice and hated iniquity .:

The heavens shall confess Your wonders, O Lord, and Your truth in the church of The saints.

Gospel:(Mt 8,28-)

At that time, when Jesus came to the other side, to the territory of the Gadarenes, two demoniacs who were coming from the tombs met him. They were so savage that no one could travel by that road. They cried out, "What have you to do with us, Son of God? Have you come here to torment us before the appointed time?" Some distance away a herd of many swine was feeding. The demons pleaded with him, "If you drive us out, send us into the herd of swine." And he said to them, "Go then!" They came out and entered the swine, and the whole herd rushed down the steep bank into the sea where they drowned. The swineherds ran away, and when they came to the town they reported everything, including what had happened to the demoniacs. Thereupon the whole town came out to meet Jesus, and when they saw him they begged him to leave their district. He entered a boat, made the crossing, and came into his own town.

Communion Verse:

Praise the Lord from the heavens; praise Him in the highest. Their utterance has gone forth into all the earth, and their words unto the ends of the world.



Lighting Our Lamp

God is fire and He is so called by all the inspired Scripture (cf Heb 12:29). The soul of each of us is a lamp. Now a lamp is wholly in darkness, even though it be filled with oil or tow or other combustible matter. until it receives fire and is kindled. So too the soul, though it may seem to be adorned with all virtues, yet does not receive the fire - in other words, has not received the divine nature and light - and is still unkindled and dark and its works are uncertain. All things must be tested and manifested by the light (cf. Eph 5:13). The man whose soul's lamp is still in darkness, that is, untouched by the divine fire, stands the more in need of a guide with a shining torch, who will discern his actions. As he has compassion for the faults he reveals in confession he will straightway straighten out whatever is crooked in his actions. Just as he who walks in the night cannot avoid stumbling, so he who has not yet seen the divine light cannot avoid falling into sin. As Christ says, "If anyone walks in the day, he does not stumble, because he sees this light. But if anyone walks in the night, he stumbles, because he has not the light in him" (Jn 11:9-10). When He said "in him," he meant the divine and immaterial light, for no one can possess the physical light in himself.
